It has been proposed, by a number of electric vehicle (EV) proponents, that an organization be formed for EV enthusiasts.

A committee of four met July 4, 1979 to prepare for and set down some proposed aims or objectives for such an association. The proposed aims are as follows:

1. To publicize the advantages of electric vehicles and to promote their use.
2. To encourage governments to implement legislation favourable to electric vehicles.
3. To aid individuals to purchase or construct an EV by providing information and/or encouragement to fellow members.
4. To enlist the support of Canadian EV manufacturers and EV component manufacturers in reaching our goal.
5. To build up a bank of EV performance data under year-round operating conditions for the use of fellow-members, government research agencies and/or EV manufacturers.
6. To bind together into a cohesive, purposeful group all those who subscribe to the above aims.

The meeting Monday at 8 pm will discuss these aims, the type of membership and fees and how to-gether we can best hasten the time when EVs take their place as part of our personal and urban transportation system.

If you believe that EVs have a place in our future, this is your opportunity to be a part of a cooperative effort to promote the development and use of electric vehicles in Canada and in this community.
